Thank you for your presentation on the AMAYDA Empowerment Program and AMAYDA Intervention Course. As discussed we would like to implement the Intervention Course next term to add to our range of support programs, centred on prevention and early intervention for young people struggling with personal challenges.

We believe that adding the program will help us further support students who may be disengaged or displaying significant behavioural issues, through a process of self-reflection and connection to others, enabling the young people to redirect their energy to more positive outcomes. The goals of the program as outlined at our meeting will assist the students to develop purpose and motivation along with strategies to address negative behaviours.

At Benowa we take a proactive stance against all forms of bullying including an online reporting program, education and student surveys through our personal development program. We support the goals of the AMAYDA Empowerment Program in taking a proactive stance in empowering our youth and changing the culture towards all forms of bullying. Adding this program for our year 7 cohort will further develop student's strategies to cope with conflict and conflict resolution skills.

We look forward to introducing the AMAYDA program in Term 4 2019 and would be keen to be part of a year 7 program in 2020.


