We believe by adding the AMAYDA Empowerment Program and the AMAYDA Intervention Course to our support interventions we will see an increase in student positive self-regulation and effective management of difficult situations. We are enthused by the positive outcomes of schools engaged in your program and are excited by the shift in positive school culture. Fostering positive interactions between our students, staff and wider community is an integral component of our school's improvement journey.

Our school has a firm stance on bullying and we would love to have your program on board however, financially the \$160,000 required to fund the full year program is just not possible. We are currently in the process of looking at implementing an online bullying reporting program and we feel that this program would complement the AMADYA program perfectly. If there were any chance of significant funding being approved, we would love to be part of a Year 7 full year program in 2020.
